To Our Valued Community Partners, Organizations, Non-Profit Agencies, and those who support the most vulnerable in our community, we want to hear from you as to how Lanark County may be able to financially assist you, as you continue with your work to best support our community during this challenging time.

BACKGROUND

On March 23rd the provincial government announced a \$200 million investment in social services relief funding to help protect the health and safety of the province's most vulnerable people in response to the outbreak of COVID-19. At this time, we are unaware of the value of the increased funding allocation from the Province, however it is our goal to be proactive and begin compiling information related to the demand for consideration by Lanark County Council.

- Value of financial aid request, including brief description of how funds would be utilized to address needs as a result of COVID-19 pandemic.
