# Native Seed

### Instructions

1. Store seed in a resealable container.
2. To prepare seeding area remove weeds, cultivate and pack soil. Avoid over packing and smoothing out the soil completely.
3. Blooms best in full sun areas.
4. Sow in late fall (best time) or early spring, avoid summer planting or in times of drought.
5. The mix will thrive in moist-mesic, well drained soils.

**Suggested Application Rate** is 15-20kg/ha

Standard: 40-60 seeds/sq foot

or 3/4-1 tbsp sq/foot
