By Name List Terminology:

Actively Homeless: Individuals or households who are currently experiencing homelessness and have active status on the By-Name List at the end of the reporting period. This includes people who are unsheltered, emergency sheltered, or provisionally accommodated and have had contact within the community's inactivity threshold (maximum 90 days).

Move-Ins → Moved to Inactive: Individuals or households who have successfully moved into housing (e.g., market housing, community housing, supportive housing, transitional housing, or long-term housing assistance) and are subsequently removed from the active BNL because they are no longer homeless. This represents an outflow from homelessness.

Newly Identified: Individuals or households who are added to the By-Name List for the first time during the reporting period after being identified as experiencing homelessness and providing consent. This category also includes people who age-in to a tracked priority population (e.g., aging into chronic homelessness, where applicable).

Aged-In: Individuals who were already known to the system but become newly counted in a priority population due to a change in eligibility over time, most commonly by:

- Aging into chronic homelessness (meeting the time-homelessness threshold), or
- Aging into the adult system from youth, where tracked separately.

Returned From Inactive: Individuals or households who were previously on the By-Name List but had been moved to inactive status (e.g., lost contact, institutional stay longer than 90 days, left community) and are later re-identified as actively homeless and returned to active status on the BNL.

Returned From Housing: Individuals or households who were previously reported as housed (a move-in) and later lost housing and returned to homelessness, re-entering the By-Name List as an inflow back into homelessness.
