## Get Ready

Unload your ATVs at a safe parking spot near the trail and head onto the RL26R Trail just off of Gambles Side Road.



## Start Here

**9:00-10:00**

### ***TAY VALLEY TO RIDEAU FERRY (RL26R TRAIL)***

Head south towards Long Lake, where you will see beautiful wetlands, rocky ridges and great lookout spots. Keep an eye out for wildlife!

## Drive On

**10:00-10:30**

### ***PORT ELMSLEY TO SMITHS FALLS (RL40R & RL1R TRAILS)***

Turn onto the RL40R trail and make your way into Port Elmsley. For a break, stop at Beveridges Locks to explore the historic Rideau Canal or walk one of the local trails.

**10:30-11:30**

### ***BREAK IN SMITHS FALLS***

Arrive in Smiths Falls and take a well-earned break after your ride with local favourites. Take a walk towards the waterfront and explore the historic Rideau Canal or visit Victoria Park area for scenic views.

**11:30-12:30**

#### **SMITHS FALLS TO CARLETON PLACE (OVRT TRAIL)**

Follow the Ottawa Valley Recreational Trail, a multi-use trail built along a former Canadian Pacific Railway corridor that links communities across Lanark County.



### Rest

**12:30-1:00**

#### **BREAK IN CARLETON PLACE**

Take a break in the historic downtown where you'll find plenty of great spots to eat and relax. Take some time to stroll along the Mississippi River waterfront or explore the charming shops and streets of downtown.
