Road Network and Transportation Master Plan

TMP Study

Lanark County is developing a new Transportation Master Plan (TMP). Much has changed since the previous TMP in 2010, and so the County requires a new plan to guide investment, address challenges, and support safe, efficient and equitable mobility for residents and visitors. The TMP study considers components of the transportation system under County jurisdiction, and focuses on improving mobility for residents and visitors across all modes: walking, cycling, transit, driving and goods movement. The outcome will be a plan that is both actionable and aligned with the County's vision for the future.

Road Needs Study

In parallel to the TMP study, a *Road Needs Study* is also underway for the following corridors to identify deficiencies and safety concerns, and recommend opportunities for improvement:

- County Road 36 (Maberly-Elphin Road), Maberly
- County Road 11 (Wilson Street/River Road), Appleton
- County Road 10 (South Street), Perth

Process

The TMP study adheres to Phases 1 and 2 of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment process under the Environmental Assessment Act. The study follows Master Plan Approach 1, which takes a broad assessment at a regional or systems scale and provides support for future investigation of recommended projects.
